<p>IV.b. Guidance for TNM Staging: Randi reported that she met with Mary Lewis. CDC has cooperative agreement with AJCC for training by Donna Gress. CDC plans to ensure there will be central cancer registry perspective in the trainings. CDC is creating tip sheets pointing out key things registrars should be aware of on general rules (clinical vs. pathologic rules). Site-specific tip sheets are being developed that are geared towards small facility or physician reporting.</p>	<p>NAACCR focus could be on consolidation aspect of TNM staging and training on new fields.</p>	<p>Randi will follow-up with Mary to see if she can share the tip sheets with the S&RD SC and if Mary has had opportunity to talk with CDC leadership regarding central registry guidelines.</p>
<p>IV.c. SMP updates: Winny reported that the Board still plans to have a combined in-person meeting in December and are looking into identifying funds for the meeting.</p>		
<p>IV.d. Standards Volume II process: Randi has been thinking about opportunities to improve the process to update Standards Volume II. Lori reported that at the S&RD SC May meeting the group agreed to follow the timeline that includes a testing phase for new data items. There was much discussion about identifying efficiencies within the process to minimize the impact on registrars and registries. The group agreed that most new data items should be field tested before they are included in Volume II. NAACCR could use the proposed standard setter spacing in the record layout to enforce timely implementation of changes.
